Key Achievements & Emerging Priorities Election Commitments

Ministerial Mayors Advisory Panel

• Establishment of a panel to provide high level advice on issues impacting local government

Direct Election of Mayor: Greater Geelong City Council

- Consultation completed
- Submissions closed 16 May 2011
- Timing of Local Government Elections
- From 2012, elections will be brought forward from late November to October.





Budget Decisions

Green Light Plan

- Also an Election Commitment \$20M over 4 years for the upgrade of energy intensive mercury vapour streetlamps to energy efficient lighting
- Public Libraries Capital Grants Program
- \$17.2M over 4 years in funding to build new libraries, refurbish and modernise existing libraries and replace or refurbish mobile libraries
- Regional Library projects are also eligible under the \$100M Local Government Infrastructure Fund

Premiers' Reading Challenge Book Fund

• \$4.5M over 4 years to public libraries to purchase books encouraging young people to read more

Flood Recovery

 \$5M Local Government Clean Up Fund to assist flood affected Councils

Bushfire Recovery

- Continuing support to bushfire affected Councils including management of the Murrindindi Shire Assistance Package
- Funding to build additional Emergency Management Capacity in Councils and the MAV

Victorian State-Local Government Agreement

 The Victorian State-Local Government Agreement will be reviewed along with development of the Local Government Ministerial Mayors Advisory Panel

Essential Services Commission pilot services report & streamlining review

 Government's response to the recommendations will focus on streamlining local government regulation and support best practice administration by councils
