



#### Introduction

 Victorian racing is recognised as the national leader.

 Racing is responsible for employment of over 70,000 people, with two-thirds in country Victoria.

 Economic impact in excess of \$2 billion per annum – with half in rural and regional Victoria.



#### **Budget Outcomes**

- Total commitment = \$79.5 million
- Unclaimed wagering dividends will be returned to the racing industry. Initiatives includes:
  - \$1 million to Living Legends
  - \$1 million to Greyhound Adoption Program
  - \$4 million to drug research
  - \$30 million to improving racetracks and facilities
  - \$10 million to breeding and sales
  - \$2 million to jumps racing
  - \$200,000 to support picnic races



#### **Budget Outcomes**

 On-course wagering taxes derived from totalisator bets will be returned to the racing industry.

 Funds will go towards the development and implementation of plans and programs to increase on-course attendances.



#### **Budget Outcomes**

 Existing Regional Racing Infrastructure Fund maintained.

- Government has provided almost \$5 million through the RRIF, including:
  - Almost \$1.8 million to build a new harness racing track at Swan Hill for the Nyah District Harness Racing Club
  - \$1.4 million for night racing lighting at Cranbourne
  - \$1 million for track and grandstand redevelopment at Bendigo

## **Early Achievements**

- COAG Select Council on Gambling Reform.
  - Sought national support for a consistent framework for racing product fees
  - Led an approach to the federal government seeking enforcement support for state based race fields legislation
- Negotiated changes to the thoroughbred racing calendar.

- Ensure a nationally consistent approach to race fields legislation.
- Ensure future wagering licence arrangements provide adequate funding for the Victorian racing industry.
- Get people back to the track.
- Provide support for country racing.
  - race meetings returned
  - racing and training facilities supported
  - a growing jumps racing sector
