

- Premier's Spirit of ANZAC Prize 2010 Schools Competition and Study Tour 2011 to Gallipoli and Western Front:
 - More than 1100 Victorian Year 9 and Year 10 students have now participated.
 - \$100,000 per year over four years to improve promotion



- Restoring Community War Memorials Grants Program:
 - Committed to continuing this program
 - 50 projects were funded this financial year with a grant value of more than \$210,000.
 - Around 70% of projects in rural and regional Victoria.
