

### A Fairer Victoria Investment 2005-2010



- Priority 1 Getting the best start
- Priority 2 Improving education and helding deopte into work
- Prior ty 3 Improving health and wellbeing.
- Prior ty 4 Developing liveable communities
- 2007 includes one-off additional investment in affordable housing.







Priority Area 1: Getting the Best Start

### \$322.2m including:

- Meeting increased kindergarten demand \$63.1m
- Continue and extend Victorian Children's Capital Program \$14.0m
- Sustaining Out of Home Care \$34.7m
- Disability Reform Program Early Childhood Intervention Service funding increase \$38.4m





Priority Area 2: Improving education and helping people into work

### \$290.3m including:

- Extending Indigenous educational opportunities through new football and dance academies
- National Partnership on Youth Attainment and Transitions \$68m and Youth Compact \$40.3m
- Victorian Deaf Institute \$9.2m
- Programs and school infrastructure for students with a disability \$103.5m






Priority Area 3: Improving health and wellbeing

\$374.5m including:

- Mental Health Reform \$58.7m and Mental Health in-patient beds \$45.9m
- Disability Reform Program \$59.1 Plus \$11.1m
- Home and Community Care \$66.7m







Priority Area 4:
Developing liveable communities

\$364.4m including:

- Improving access to justice:
  - Victoria Legal Aid \$49.9m
  - Responding to Court Demand \$64.4m
  - Reform of equal opportunity legislation
- Supporting community facilities and infrastructure \$26m
- Transport connections \$22.8
- Rooming Houses \$77.2m







# Community Support Fund Expenditure 2009-10








# Community Support Fund Expenditure 2010-11
