Our school rebuilding program is the biggest in the State's history, demonstrating our commitment to giving every child the best opportunity to learn, grow and shine.













- Two key programs:
 - Victorian Schools Plan (VSP)
 - \$1.9 billion Victorian Schools Plan
 - Building the Education Revolution (BER)
 - Delivering the \$2.5 billion Commonwealth program to Victorian government schools













Victorian Schools Plan

- \$1.9 billion VSP commitment delivered:
 - 553 schools funded
 - 20 new schools
 - 42 small rural replacement schools
 - 400 modern relocatable classrooms
 - 30 new tech wings in Secondary Schools
 - 2 new select entry schools













Victorian Schools Plan - \$334.4 million in 2010-11 Budget.

- \$230.3 million in new Victorian Schools Plan funding, including:
 - Modernisation projects
 - Regeneration projects
 - Rural replacement schools
 - New schools
 - Replacement specialist school;
 - Fire reinstatement
 - Planning
 - Land acquisition
- \$104.1 million from 10/11 budget pre-announced to combine with BER projects.

- \$2.5 billion for new facilities and refurbishments to Victorian government schools.

Building Education Revolution

- Overall program management
 - The Commonwealth provided 1.5% on top of project funding for program administration.
- Individual project management
 - Project management costs are within Commonwealth guidelines.
- Value for money outcomes
 - Rigorous public tender strategy and cost benchmarking.
 - Entire project subject to Commonwealth and State audit processes














- Building Education Revolution delivering high quality outcomes, with:

Bushfire recovery



- **\$3.4 million** provided for three schools being rebuilt
- **\$6 million** provided for three early years facilities being rebuilt
- **\$41 million** provided to increase bushfire resistance of school facilities

- This is on top of a range of other initiatives supporting non-government schools.









Student Attitudes to School: School Connectedness, mean scores*, Years 5-12, 2006-2009
















Massive investment in education
