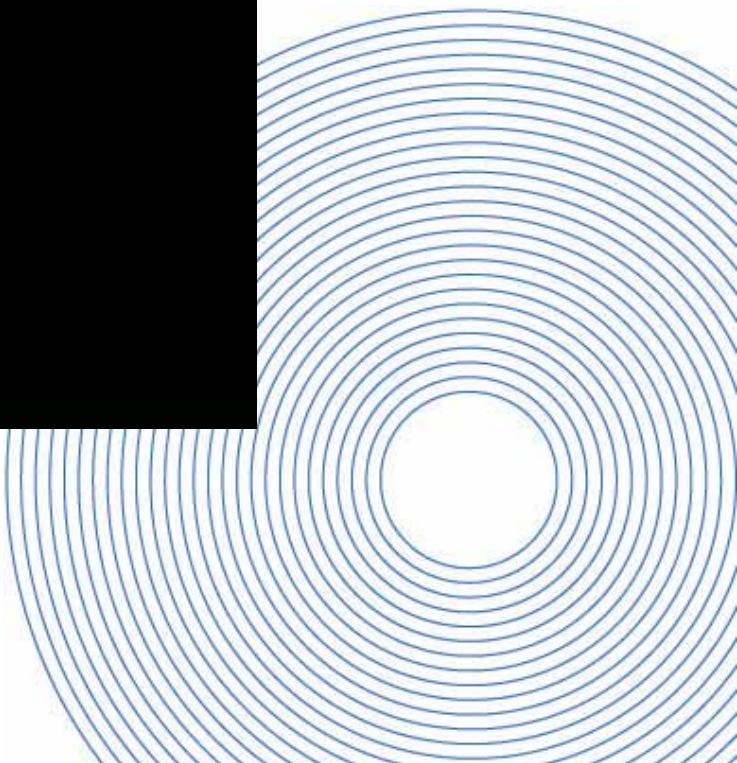
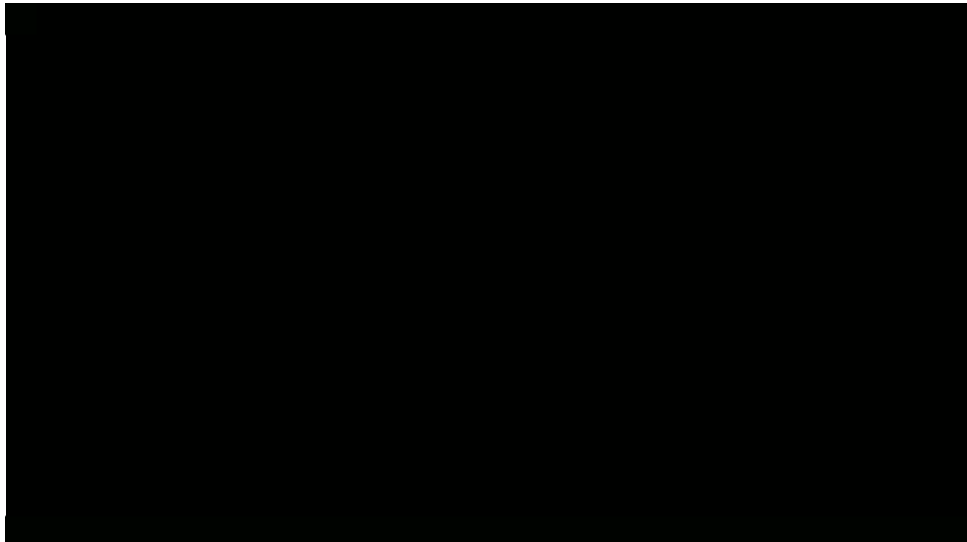
ICT Sector Trends
