Building on reforms: 2010-11 Priorities



2010-11 BUDGET INCLUDES \$72.1 MILLION TO MANAGE GROWTH, PROTECT LIFESTYLE AND BUILD FOR THE FUTURE

Managing population growth – *Melbourne@ 5 Million*

- \$10.4million over four year for CADS and Employment Corridors.
- \$9.5 million over five years for urban renewal in Footscray.

Protecting the lifestyle of Victorian families

- Investing in a Growing Geelong.
- Investing in Community Infrastructure.
- Heritage Grants.
- Working with communities to build strong, vibrant neighbourhoods where families want to live.
- Integration with *Victorian Transport Plan*.

Building for the future

- Development Facilitation securing investment.
- \$5.9 million over four years to develop housing and employment data to plan for future development.
- \$8.3 million over four years to continue the Expert Assistance Program, which provides grants and technical advice to metropolitan councils to develop and implement structure plans in activity centres.
