 - More than 120 faiths

- We place a high priority on the Multicultural Affairs portfolio, which is administered through the Victorian Multicultural Commission (VMC)
- The VMC is a statutory authority that provides advice to the Government regarding our culturally, linguistically and religiously diverse society as well as delivering a range of highly successful programs
- Its objectives and functions are defined under the Multicultural Victoria Act 2004
