MAJOR PROJECTS PORTFOLIO

Mr SCOTT asked: I will seek some indulgence from you, Chair, in this supplementary. I
made reference to the photographs and other images. I would just be grateful if the minister
could outline how much money is spent on photographs, artists' impressions, and other aerial
shots for his department, because I think it is an extraordinary presentation with a very large
portion of it devoted to such materials. If you could provide that information, maybe on
notice, to the committee.

RESPONSE

All the images that were contained in the presentation were images that Major Projects Victoria (MPV) already held on file. The only cost in developing the presentation was the time of the MPV officer who put together the PowerPoint presentation.

MPV has a long standing policy of using artists' impressions and photographs to visually document State Government projects. Artists' impressions are used prior to construction to communicate the scope and design of the building, while photographs are used during construction to record progress.

MPV's project images are shared across government and used to promote the projects and the State of Victoria. Recent uses include the 2013-14 Budget Papers, various State Government trade missions, international marketing campaigns and Ministerial speech presentations.
