Flood inquiry to hold open mic next week

Flood-affected Victorians can share their stories with MPs on a parliamentary committee investigating the October 2022 flood event at a new open mic session next week.

The event will be held online via Zoom from 7 pm on Wednesday 18 October.

“We will be looking to prioritise people who haven’t already had the opportunity to engage with our inquiry by making a submission or speaking at a public hearing,” Committee Chair Sonja Terpstra said.

“Committee Members look forward to people sharing their experience and telling us about any of the challenges they have faced since the flood.”

The Legislative Council Environment and Planning Committee has already held public hearings throughout regional Victoria, at Rochester, Echuca, Shepparton and Seymour.
