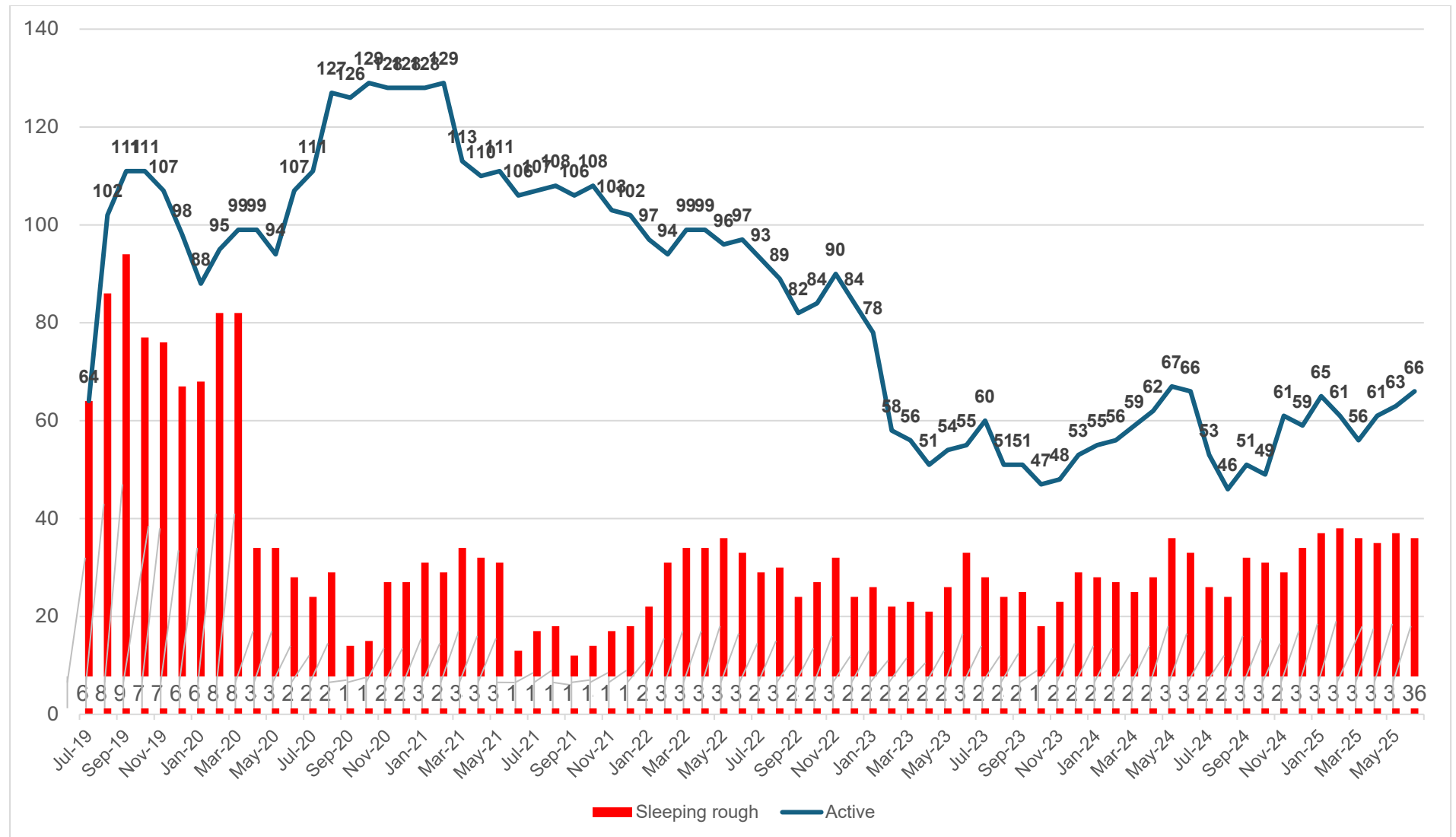


Port Phillip and Stonnington Zero: By the numbers and demography – seeking to achieve Functional Zero rough sleeping homelessness

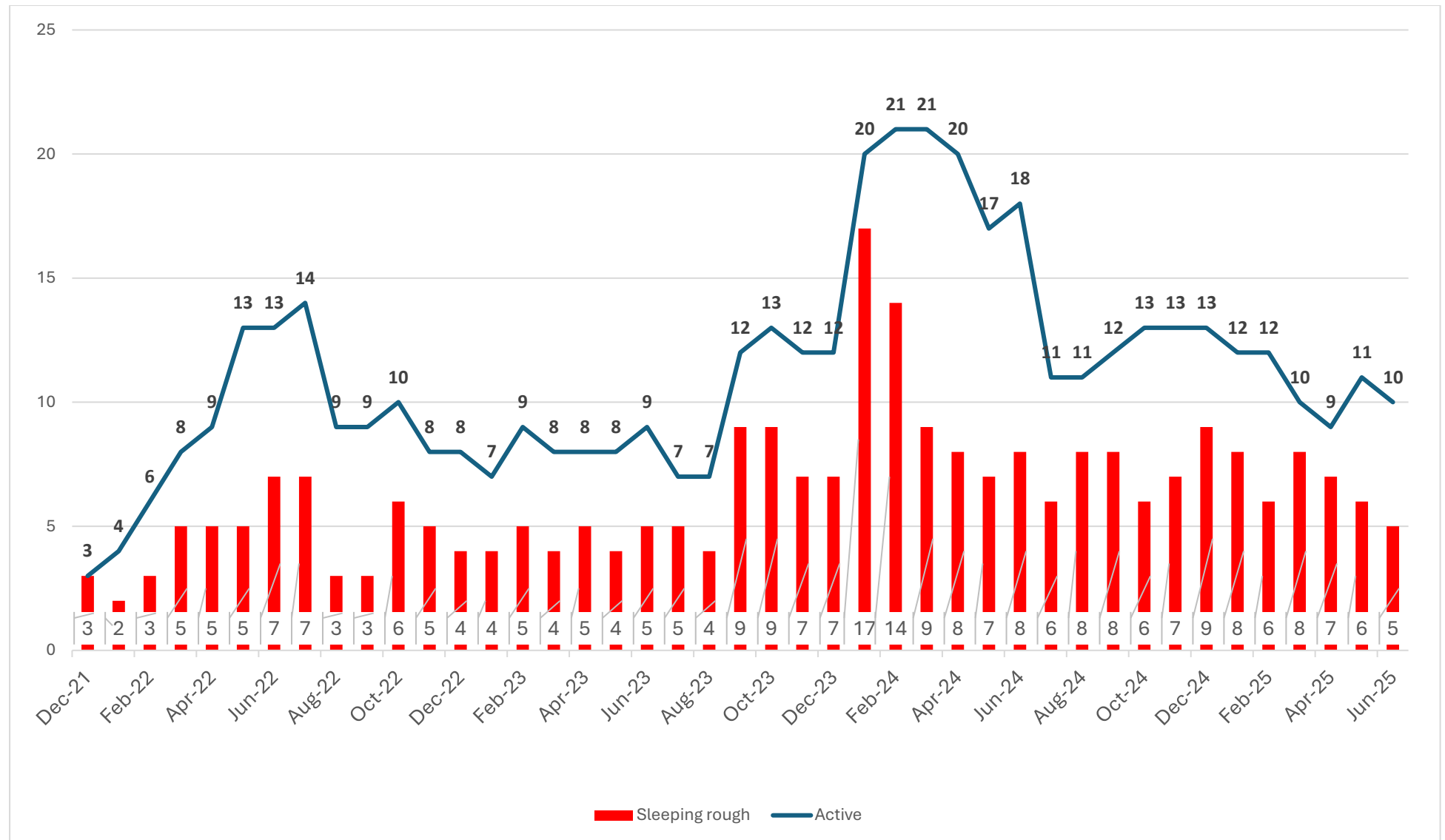
Functional zero homelessness will be reached when the number of people entering and experiencing rough sleeping homelessness within the month (the active number) is less than the average 6-monthly placement rate into long-term housing, or the number of people recorded as actively homeless on a by name list is 3, whichever is lesser.
