
# Inquiry into Wildlife Roadstrike in Victoria

## Wildlife impacts

Estimated annual wildlife roadstrike in Australia:

4 million marsupials & 6 million birds

Over **40,000 frogs** killed along a 4km stretch of road in NSW during an average summer.

#### Wildlife Victoria (2023–24):

>15,000 animals reported as hit by vehicles

#### **Veterinary clinics:**

90% never recoup costs for treating wildlife


Estimated causes of wildlife admissions across Australia:

**82%** due to vehicular trauma, other trauma, or predation





## Public safety



Victoria Police Traffic Incident System:

**749 incidents** from 2020 to 2024.

Victorian road crash database (Jan 2012 – Aug 2024):

92.3% of fatalities occurred in 100 km/h zones86.9% of serious injuries occurred in 80 km/h+ zones

Wildlife collisions claims cost an average of \$5,500 - \$6,400, with 1 in 7 collisions causing damage so severe the car is written off (AAMI)



#### Recommendation roadmap

- 1. Establish cross-sectoral reference group to develop and implement urgent priority actions regarding a centralised database, faunasensitive development, and mitigation strategies
- 2. Update critical legislation to protect the welfare of wildlife
- **3. Bolster the response to roadstrike** through immediate funding support, streamlining systems, and implementing statewide standardised training






Figure 1.: An overview of the developed LAARMA system.

 Only 19% 'definitely' knows what to do or who to call if they hit wildlife with their car




 78% of Victorians are in support of an app to report wildlife roadstrike



 Misconceptions about high-risk driving times:


58% said dusk31% said nightOnly 9% said dawn





#### Response

- Centralise reporting for members of the public - one number, one app, no second step
- \$2 car registration levy
- Implement standardised training
