Hearings continue in probe of IBAC's legislative framework

The Victorian Parliament's Integrity and Oversight Committee will hold its second round of public hearings on Monday 25 August 2025.

The Committee is undertaking an inquiry into the adequacy of the legislative framework for the Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission (IBAC).

"The hearings are helping the Committee consider the definition and scope of 'corrupt conduct', the threshold for IBAC to investigate alleged corrupt conduct, and the circumstances in which IBAC can hold public hearings," said the Committee's Chair, Dr Tim Read.

"We will also investigate issues affecting IBAC's capacity to effectively identify, investigate and expose corruption, and to oversight police," he said.

The Centre for Public Integrity will appear from 1:20 pm, followed by—in order of appearance—the Australian Lawyers Alliance, Integrity Oversight Victoria, The Police Association Victoria, Police Oversight Working Group, and ANU's Dr Adam Masters.

The full hearing schedule and witness information is available on the Committee's website, where transcripts from the hearings will also be published in due course.

The public hearings will be broadcast on the Victorian Parliament's <u>website</u> from 1:20 pm and replayed there at 7:00 pm on Monday 25 August 2025.
