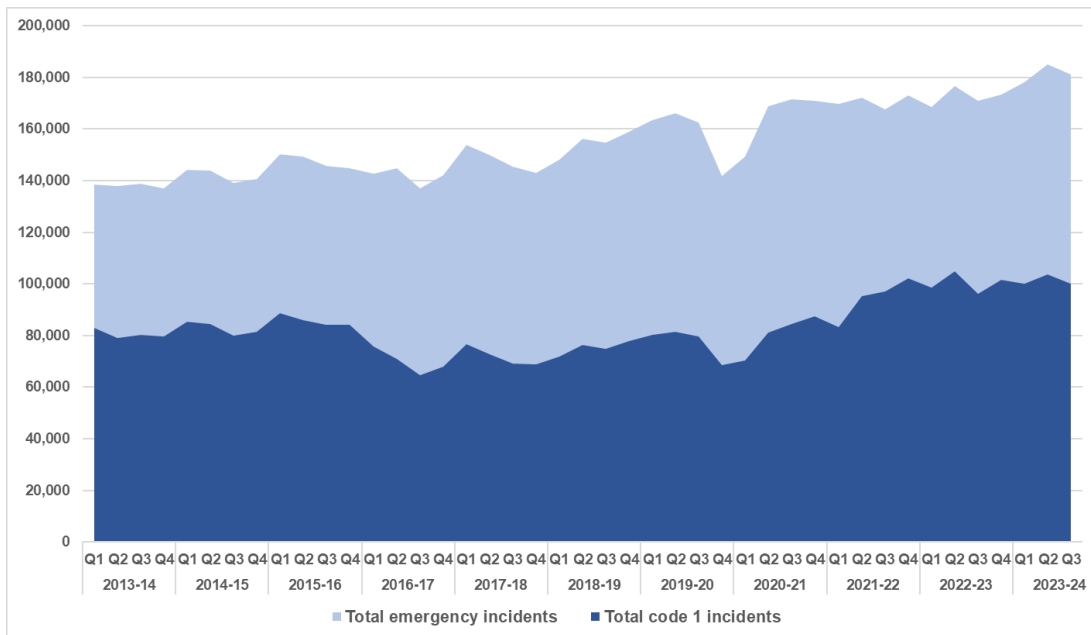

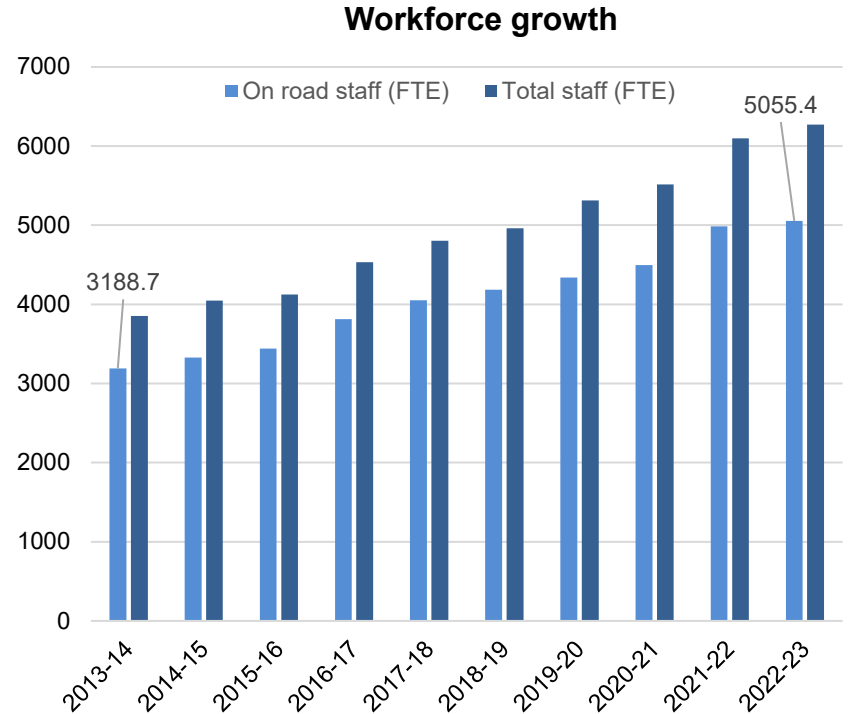
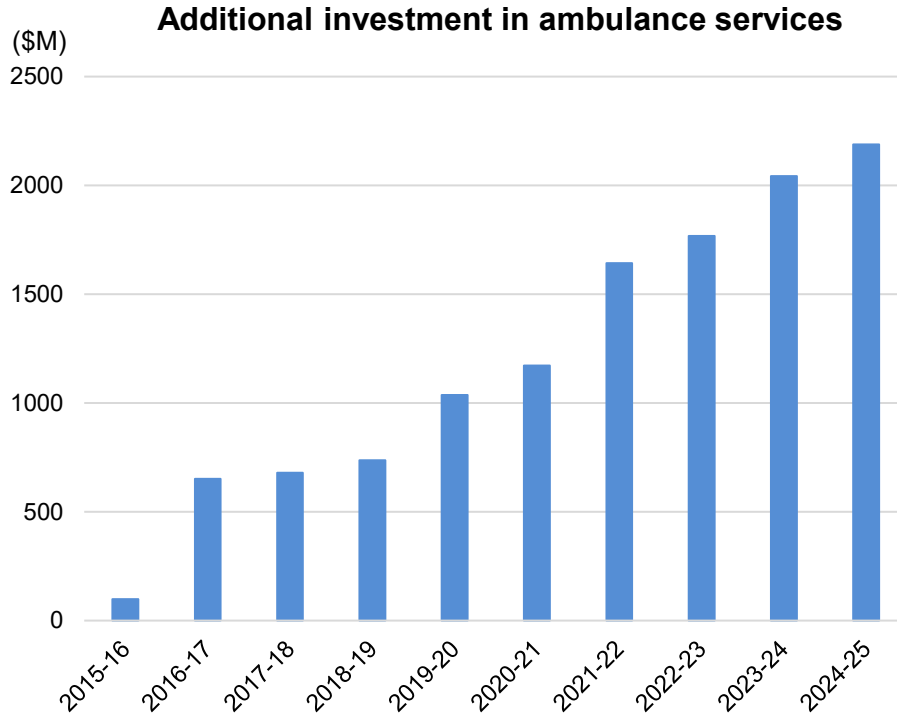

Delivering for Victorians

- 67.7% Code 1 cases responded to in 15 mins between Jan-March 2024, **over 2% better** than same time last year
- Average Code 1 response time between Jan-March 2024 was **30 seconds faster** than the same time last year
- In 2022-23, Victoria compared favourably to NSW across response time and cardiac measures



A growing service and workforce



Connecting people to the right care

\$146.3 million to deliver the care people need, when they need it, by relieving pressure on our paramedic workforce.

Priority Primary Care Centres

\$34.4 million to continue 19 state funded clinics

Secondary Triage Services

\$27.2 million to continue 43 referral practitioners

Victorian Virtual Emergency Department

\$235 million to double the capacity

Medium Acuity Transport

\$81.3 million to continue 22 crews

Timely Emergency Care Collaborative

\$3.3 million to continue work with health services to reduce pressure on ambulance and ED
