


Justice Budget 2008-09






Police Budget 2000-01 to 2008-09



 - New career structure




Victorian Crime Rate 1991-92 to 2006-07




- Since 1999:
 - -The CFA budget has increased by 130%. From \$113.8 million to \$260 million in 2007-08
 - The MFESB budget has increased by 93.9%. From \$131 million to \$254 million in 2007-08
 - The VICSES budget has increased by 143.3%. From \$9.7 million to \$23.6 million in 2007-08
