Snapshot of Young People in Victoria

- Young people aged between 12 and 25 comprise 17.7% of Victoria's population.
- There is significant diversity among Victoria's young people.
- 73% of young Victorians were living in the Melbourne metropolitan area in 2006.
- 19.9% of Victorians aged 12-24 speak a language other than English at home.
- Young people today are a technological generation, with technology enabling them to communicate, network and learn in new ways.
