- 7,512 community corrections offenders (incls parolees)


Correctional facilities in Victoria

- Staff: incls. Prisons, CCS, Head Office: 2,385




Judy Lazarus Transition Centre

Major Offenders in Prison









- \$25m to over five years to expand prison capacity
