

BreastScreen Victoria Project

BreastScreen Victoria (BSV) aims to reduce deaths from breast cancer through early detection.

The Rural Broadband Digital Mammography Project (RBDMP) uses digital technology and broadband to connect the mobile screening service to the regional assessment centre.

BSV received \$1.9 million from the Victorian State Government towards this project.

This project has delivered many benefits to women in regional Victoria.

Following the success of this project the State is providing \$10 million to roll out digital breast screening services across Victoria.
