Achievements for 2006-07

Public Libraries

- Record recurrent funding of \$28.94 million
- 10 Living Libraries Program projects completed (total of 70 funded to date)
- LibraryLink Victoria commenced operating

Neighbourhood Houses

- Increase of 62% in recurrent funding
- 34% increase in funded co-ordination hours
- 127 projects funded in 2006 through the Modernising Neighbourhood Houses Program

Local Government Partnerships

 Draft Victorian State-Local Government Agreement endorsed for consultation.
