Achievements in 2006-07

- Multicultural and Multifaith Harmony
- Language Services Strategy
- Refugee Brokerage Program
- Victorian Multicultural Community Grants
- Merger of the Victorian Office of Multicultural Affairs (VOMA) into the Victorian Multicultural Commission (VMC)



New Budget Initiatives

Three major cultural precincts to be refurbished: Lygon, Lonsdale and Little Burke Streets

•\$8m investment to restore key lane ways, undertake street beautification and boost resources to communities to showcase their cultural heritage.

Increased funding to the Ethnic Communities' Council of Victoria (ECCV)

•Increase of core funding from \$180,000 to \$250,000 per annum.

Establish DW Hope Multicultural Centre in Norlane, Geelong

Up to \$1m in matched funding



New Budget Initiatives (cont.)

Increased funding to VMC's Community Grants Program

Additional funding of \$4 million over 4 years.

Increased funding for Community Harmony Initiatives

Additional funding of \$2m over 2 years.
