
Justice 2007-08 Budget


Share of \$3,155.30 million budget





POLICE BUDGET


Police Budget: 2000/01 to 2007/08



- Biggest police budget in history
 - Total of \$1.64 billion for 07/08
 - Up by 55.4 per cent from 1999/00
- \$87m over 4 years :
 - 350 new police
 - 25 specialist crime fighters
- \$8.8m for
 - 25 forensic investigators
 - Additional equipment
- \$86m for eight new police stations



Emergency Services 2005 - 06




- Emergency Services Telecommunications Authority
 - Handled around 1.5million calls for help
- Metropolitan Fire Brigade
 - More than 33,000 fires and rescues
- Country Fire Authority
 - Handled 33,325 incidents
- Victoria State Emergency Service
 - Over 10,000emergencies and calls for help
- Life Saving Victoria
 - 1,185 water rescues

Victoria State Emergency Service (VICSES)



- 5,500 Volunteers; 88 Staff
- Enacted as a Statutory Authority in November 2005 with new Act, CEO and 7-member Board
- The 2007-08 Budget provides VICSES with:
 - \$37m for:
 - increased operational costs
 - new information technology systems and broadband access for units
 - Training and equipment.
 - \$8M for new and improved Units
 - \$4M for equipment including trucks trailers and 4WDs.
