Government Key Achievements 2000-07

Key achievements within the *four key themes* of the women's portfolio:

Representation & Equity

- Achieved target of <u>40% women on government boards and committees</u> (up from 31% in 1999).
- Increased women Chairs from 12% to 28% (at 2005-06).

Education, Work & Economic Independence

- <u>386 Victorian women inducted onto the Honour Roll</u>, valuing women's contributions in science, health, sport, acting, politics, social justice and community service.
- <u>500 women attended Women & Money</u>: Workshops for a Financially Fit Future 77% took action towards financial planning.

Justice & Safety

- Launch of the landmark <u>Women's Safety Strategy 2002-07</u> whole of government commitment of 60 initiatives to reduce level and fear of violence against women.
 - \$35.1 million to develop an integrated response to family violence linking police and legal response with increased services and support to victims.
 - \$34.2 million to strengthen and improve the system response to sexual assault

Health, Wellbeing & Community Strengthening

• Launch of two whole of government *Women's Health & Well Being Strategies* (2002 & 2006).



Government Key Achievements 2006-07

- Continued implementation of the <u>New Approach to Family Violence</u> including <u>Risk Assessment Framework</u> and <u>Family Violence Partnerships</u> in 9 regions
- Met target of 40% representation by women on <u>government boards & committees</u>
- Increased participation of women and women's organisations in the <u>Queen</u> <u>Victoria Women's Centre</u> from 3,000 in 2005-06 to more than 17,000 in 2006-07
- Held 7th Premier's Annual Women's Summit 2006 <u>Respecting Diversity:</u> <u>Harmony in Practice</u> and allocated <u>\$250,000 in grants</u> for women-led community harmony projects
- Conducted the first dedicated <u>Yarnin' Up</u> consultations with Victorian Indigenous Women in 3 regional locations
- Added 30 women to the <u>Victorian Honour Roll of Women</u> (386 inducted since 2001)
