

  - Fostering responsible gambling








# Gambling trends – EGM density

# Gambling trends – problem gambling



- Problem gambling prevalence halved, from 2.14% in 1999 to 1.12% in 2004
- Increase in the proportion of problem gamblers in counselling, from 4.7% in 1999 to 13.9% in 2004-05
- Decline in the proportion of household consumption spent on gambling, from 3.8% between June 2000 to September 2002 to 3.3% in 2005-06.

- **Systematic strategy to address challenges created by gambling through regulatory and population-based actions:**
  - Market integrity controls
  - Consumer protection measures
  - Social Regulation
  - Community education and public health strategy
  - Open and informed decisions

# Achievements 2005/06 – regulatory actions



- **Ensuring market integrity:**
  - Commercial raffle organisers regulations
  - Sports betting reform
  - 9<sup>th</sup> variation of the Casino Agreement
- **Consumer protection**
  - Prohibition of issuing of cash cheques for winnings over \$2,000
  - Signage restrictions and advertising bans
  - VCGR community information sessions
- **Social regulation**
  - Regional Caps review
  - Amendments to the Victoria Planning Provisions
  - Gaming venue staff training requirements

# Achievements 2005/06 – community engagement



- **Problem gambling strategy**
  - \$34.7m for Problem Gambling Strategy 2005-07
  - Services for CALD and Indigenous communities
  - After hours initiative
  - Stage 4 of the Community Awareness and Education campaign
  - Community partnerships
- **Open and informed decisions**
  - Community Advocacy Project
  - Responsible Gambling Ministerial Advisory Council
  - Victorian Gambling Research Agenda
  - Pilot submission-based grant system for Victorian gambling research
