


VICTORIAN CRIME RATE

Official recorded crime rate for Victoria 96/97 to 04/05




POLICE NUMBERS


- Biggest police budget in history
 - Total of \$1.6 billion for 06/07
 - Up by 50 per cent from 1999
- \$109m to fight organised crime and terrorism
 - \$15.4 forensic CSI
- 145 new police stations
- High-tech mobile data terminals



Mobile data network








Driving down the road toll







- 346 killed last year
 - Third lowest in history
- Road toll halved since 1989
- On track for record low

Road safety budget boost



- \$14.1 million for drug driving
 - Testing capability to all booze buses + extra bus
 - Expand capacity to 17,000 random tests per year
- \$4.3 million for police in-car video
 - Record activities outside the patrol car
 - Capture evidence of people breaking the law
- Over \$12 million for hoon driving



Emergency Services




- Emergency Services Telecommunications Authority
 - Handled around 1.5 million 000 calls for help
- Metropolitan Fire Brigade
 - More than 30,000 fires and rescues
- Country Fire Authority
 - Tackled 39,825 incidents
- State Emergency Service
 - 13,520 emergencies and calls for help
- Life Saving Victoria
 - 1,188 water rescues
