Key agencies at drug law reform hearing

This Monday 4 September, health and corrections agencies will present evidence to the parliamentary inquiry into drug law reform.

The public hearing by the Law Reform, Road and Community Safety Committee will be held from 9:45 am to 3:30 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

The Committee will also hear from academics and researchers.

Under the inquiry's terms of reference, the Committee is examining how effectively laws, procedures and regulations minimise drug-related harms.

It is considering approaches to drug law reform in other Australian states and territories and overseas jurisdictions.

The Committee is also looking at how other positive reforms could be adopted into Victorian law.
