Drug law reform hearings begin

Public hearings will commence on Monday 8 May for the parliamentary inquiry into drug law reform.

The Law Reform, Road and Community Safety Committee will hear from key research and advocacy groups at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne from 9:45 am to 4:00 pm.

The Committee is examining how effectively laws, procedures and regulations minimise drug-related harms.

As part of the inquiry, the Committee will consider approaches to drug law reform in other Australian states and territories and overseas jurisdictions.

It will also look at how other positive reforms could be adopted into Victorian law.
