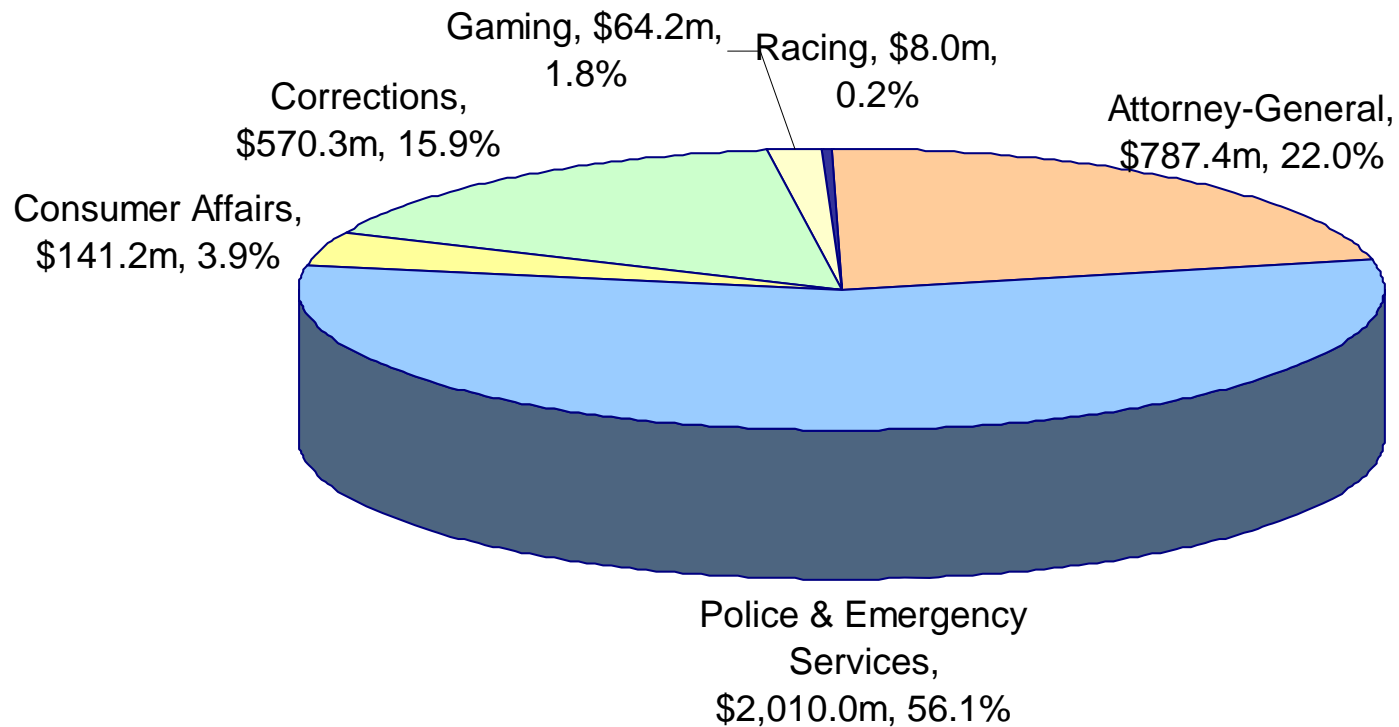
Justice Budget Breakdown

Share of \$3,581.1 Million Budget

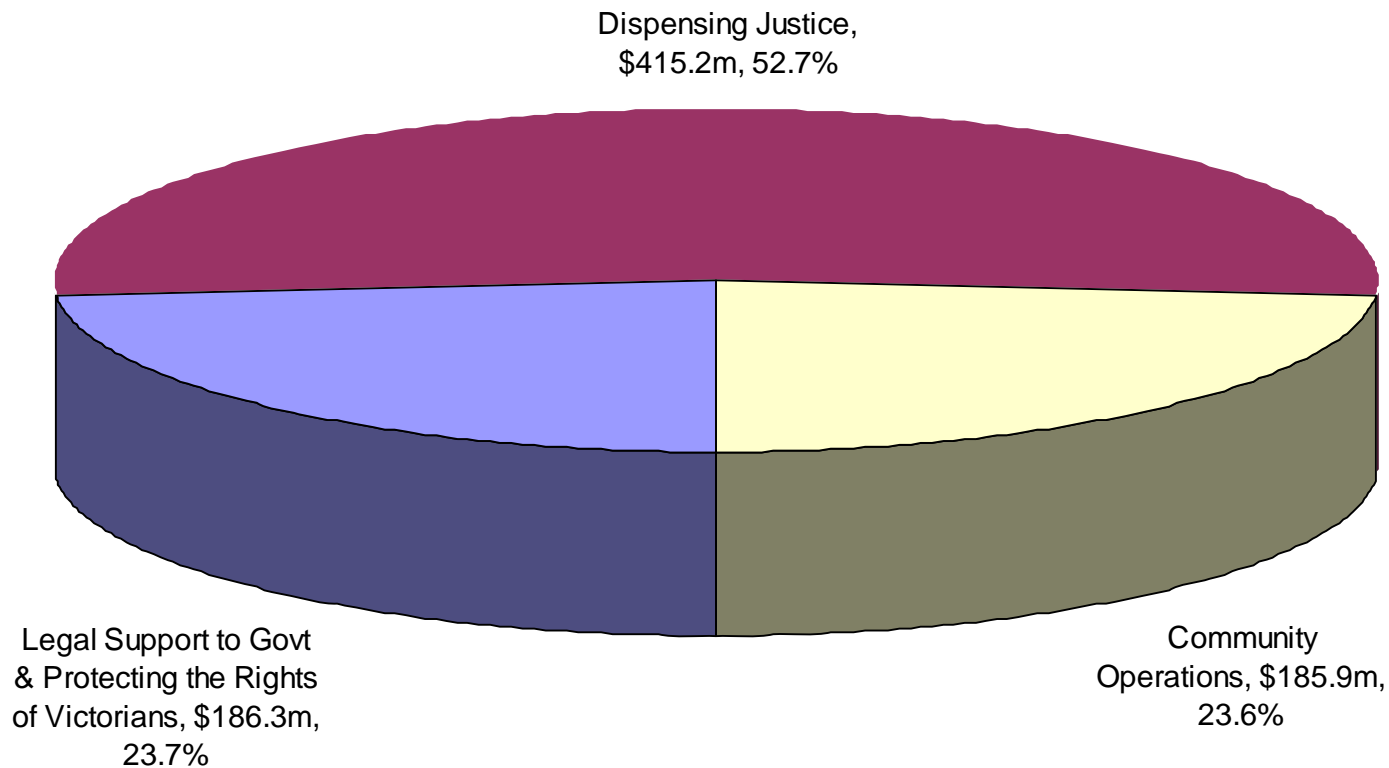

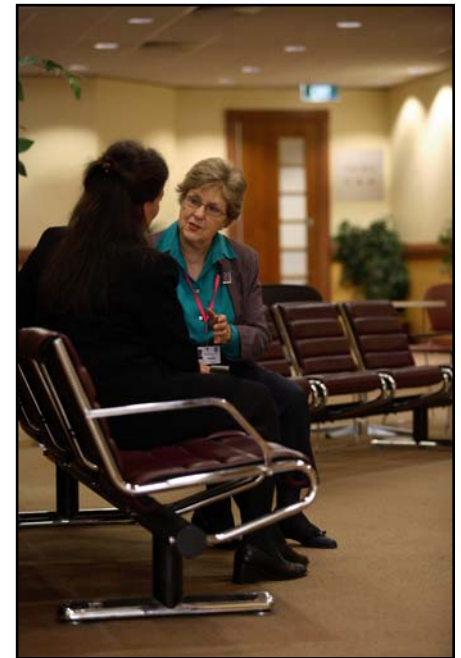
