NOTICE OF APPROVAL
of
AMENDMENT TO A PLANNING SCHEME
To Be Presented
TO PARLIAMENT

On 11 August 2021 the Minister approved Amendment No. VC173 to the *Victoria Planning Provisions* (VPP).

The amendment was prepared by the Minister for Planning.

The municipal councils of the the City of Banyule, the City of Bayside, the City of Boroondara, the City of Brimbank, the Shire of Cardinia, the City of Casey, the City of Darebin, the City of Frankston, the City of Glen Eira, the City of Greater Dandenong, the City of Hobsons Bay, the City of Hume, the City of Kingston, the City of Knox, the Shire of Macedon Ranges, the City of Manningham, the City of Maribyrnong, the City of Maroondah, the City of Melbourne, the City of Melton, the Shire of Mitchell, the City of Monash, the City of Moonee Valley, the City of Moreland, the Shire of Mornington Peninsula, the Shire of Nillumbik, the City of Port Phillip, the City of Stonnington, the City of Whitehorse, the City of Whittlesea, the City of Wyndham, the City of Yarra, will be responsible for administering the provisions amended by the Amendment in their municipal districts.

The Minister for Planning will be responsible for administering the provisions in this Amendment for the the Port of Melbourne Planning Scheme. The Minister for Planning will also be responsible for administering those areas as specified in the schedule to Clause 72.01.

The changes to the VPP and the various planning schemes are: updates the land affected by the Melbourne Airport Environs Overlay in the Brimbank, Hume, Melton, Moreland, Moonee Valley and Whittlesea municipalities consistent with the Melbourne Airport Master Plan 2018, which was approved by the Federal Government in 2019. The Amendment includes limited transition provisions and consequential updates to the VPP and affected planning schemes.

The Minister exempted the Minister from the requirements of Sections 17, 18 and 19 of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987** being the requirement to make the Amendment available for inspection and to give notice of the amendment.

The Minister did not prepare the amendment under section 20A of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**.

No notice of the Amendment was given.

The Minister did not consult the responsible authorities.
