

Promote your Legislative Council e-petition



The Principal Petitioner and signatories are responsible for raising awareness in the community about a petition.

Parliament of Victoria encourages petitioners to use the following steps to raise awareness and gain signatures for their e-petition.



EMAIL



Engage family, friends and colleagues with a short email inviting them to support your cause by joining your e-petition.

Remember to provide a link to Parliament of Victoria's website. It is recommended to blind carbon copy (BCC) when sending emails to a large number of recipients.

Include all information necessary for someone to make an informed decision, including the closing date.

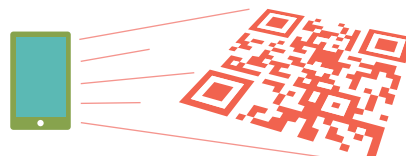
SOCIAL MEDIA



Share a link to your e-petition on a range social media platforms, to increase your audience add hashtags based on keywords.

Keep in mind that users who share your post may have access to some of your personal information depending on your privacy settings.
