1. The CFA must remain a fully independent organisation with its Chief Officer, CEO and Board committed to this independence and its volunteer base.
2. Operations, Training & Community Safety Staff must be employed by CFA and independent of FRV, as the proposed Bill has recommended that these Staff be seconded from FRV and thus, by proxy, gives the UFU an influence into an independent voluntary organisation. Operational Staff could be sourced from any career fire department or service in Australia, not just Victoria.
3. CFA must be fairly and adequately funded.
