I am writing to you to express my concern about onshore gas in Victoria particularly

In my area.

My wife and I moved to Seaspray in 2011 where we found out via an information day what was proposed for our area with onshore gas. If we had known what was proposed we would not have moved here. 98% of our community have voted no to onshore gas. I am concerned of the risks to our water which is taken from Merrimans Creek which Lake's Oil has a well nearby, not to mention the close proximity to our community school. I am stressed over our future and the investment I have made in purchasing our property, I am afraid my business may also suffer.

Can the Government guarantee 100% that if this goes ahead there will be no risk to our water, food production, property values, tourism and seismic activity?

This industry is after one thing and that's money, they lie through their teeth to get what they want. I viewed the local news after the inquiry in Sale and Lake's Oil people lying again and again, stating that was no opposition to what they were doing. The current moratorium has been granted due to the direct action our community in Seaspray and other communities around Victoria have taken in opposition to onshore gas.

We will do whatever it takes too protect our community and other communities to have onshore gas totally banned in Victoria.
