To Whom It May Concern

I am writing to express my concern at the lack of law enforcement towards activists that illegally enter farms placing at risk the biosecurity and well being of our animals, the safety of our people and the potential impact upon our business and ability to meet customer expectations on delivery and quality of products.

Our business farms 1.50m chickens producing nearly 7m eggs per week, of which 1.50m are used by CSL LTD in the manufacture of Human Influenza Vaccine, if the hens producing these eggs were adversely impacted upon the ramifications for Australia's public health are significant. Furthermore we employ 156 people in regional area's across Victoria.
