As long as there are laws that allow this to happen there will be people trying to stop it. Change the law and the people will change, the practices will change and lives of animals will change... for the better.

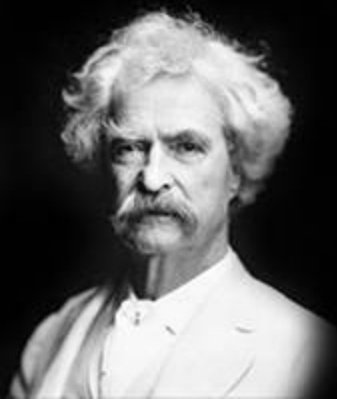
