There is a need to monitor the treatment of animals on farms and industrialised factory farms and abattoirs. Video evidence from whistleblowers and rescuers has shown evidence of animal cruelty. Whistleblowers are often workers in/on the farms who see direct animal abuse and cruelty. There doesn't seem to be any other way of exposing animal abuse and cruelty.
