I believe that the free zone should be extended to at least one stop around some of the most busiest and the most prevalent stations, that for all intensive purposes are considered by most people to be part of the CBD.

For example, the stop outside the Melbourne Exhibition and Convention centre is to be considered the first stop outside the zone, which I would argue that the entire front line of Southbank is still considered the "city" by Victorians.

Another stop would be at RMIT, which is only a few hundred metres from the Melbourne Central stop yet is considered to be outside zone due to falling out of the CBD rectangle.

In principle, I believe that the extension should be taking into account frequented and high profile stops that are in close proximity to the inner CBD.
