Submission re free tram fares:

It is discriminatory if free tram fares are not also made available to part-time students. Students studying part-time are often doing so due to disability or family responsibilities.

The main criterion should be that they are currently a student and can produce a current and valid student card.

In fact, a student card does not normally state full-time or part-time. It will be a lot simpler and easier if the eligibility criterion is the fact that the person is simply a currently enrolled student.
