My suggestion to reduce the road toll is the following;

“All vehicles must have their head lights on at all times whilst driving”.

I suggest that for the following reasons;

Currently, headlights are only switched on at night and/or during inclement weather.

Many drivers have their lights on auto control which will turn their lights on by a sensor when it is dark. This sensor is variable so, vehicle headlights will often not turn on until it is very dark, or they won't turn on during inclement weather.
