On the road out to StAndrews we are often passed to close by cars and particularly trucks. At these times it is quite frightening and makes it more difficult to keep to a straight line. With this current law you don't have any comeback as there isn't a set distance that you can argue about. With the possible new rule where a metre to a metre and half distance is required you can at least point out to the driver that they have driven to close.

I am in support of this new rule which specifies a set distance from the rider and has been promoted by the Amy Gillet foundation for years.
