Hi there, my name is Alexandra Mullins and I am a regular cyclist on the road in Melbourne.

I ride both to and from work, and while I do have a car, it is my predominant form of transport.

I fully support the proposed idea to introduce the 1-1.5m overtaking rule. This will allow me to feel safer on roads when I am trapped riding between parked cars and overtaking cars (a frequent problem I face on St Kilda road on a daily basis).

We need more safety rules in place to get more riders on the road and, more importantly, reduce deaths and injury amongst current riders. Riding is a great way to encourage daily health and fitness - but I feel that the safety measures in place are minimal and restricting the number of People willing to ride (particularly female riders).
