I would like to make my submission to the enquiry into the RSPCA.

RSPCA need to be stopped by the relevant authorities of acting in a gestapo way.

Prior to the seizure of ANY animal, RSPCA must show due cause for the seizure and only do so after notice has been given (In writing) to the owner and the owner being given the opportunity of reply.

RSPCA should be stopped from leaving notes on doors saying your animal has been seized,

RSPCA should issue matter of course or copy of the complaint (with personal details blacked out).

Verbal complaints whilst taken and considered should not be acted upon (one word against another).

RSPCA to permit and listen (consider) 2nd opinion from outside veterinarians instead of relying only on their own Veterinarian.

RSPCA to cease telling members of the public making a complaint that "this does not fall within our legislation)

Remove the power of the RSPCA to set their own legislation and abide by the Cruelty to Animals Act.

No Act/legislation should be given Royal Assent to the RSPCA as they are a charity.

Enquiry to review the RSPCA constitution and amend as required.

Be transparent and put on their own web site what is deemed cruelty according to the Cruelty to Animals Act not their own perception.

Not seize any animal without the owner being present.
