i have had several complaints given to me which i have passed on to the rspca, all which i believe needed action.

None of them had anything done,.

1. my neighbours dogs live in a concrete pen all day and at night they are on a concret balcony. They are never out. I complained 6 mths ago and they are still living in the same conditions.
- 2 .a maltese in appaling condition with an old broken leg.

Nothing was done,.

3. A very skinny dog that ended up being taken by concerned residence to the vets because rpsca didn't do anything.
- 4 .A dog that had been abandoned for a month was just left. The rspca said it was in good condition.. . It was in good body condition because it was being fed by the neighbours. The dog was eventually let out of the yard and was taken to the pound by rescue.
5. One very skinny dog, someone complained about. the rspca visited and said the dog was old (because the owners said she was 18) and needed to be euthanased or surrendered to rescue. The people couldn't afford to feed her so they rang rescue. We had her vet checked and all her vet work done ,she has since put on 10kgs and is fit and healthy. The vet thinks maybe 11 yrs but we think younger. These people have 2 mother cats with kittens and a new maltese puppy. Plus another dog in the back yard. I believe nothing else was done.
6. 2 dogs in Wangaratta, were very skinny.. the outcome was that they are that sort of breed and are young. i saw the photos and they were skinny
