Re: Investigation into RSPCA VICTORIA

Unique French Bulldogs has always supported adoption from the RSPCA and the choice to buy animals without homes from RSPCA. However, the enquiry into this facility and where its funds are being spent, I believe, should be conducted by an independent body. My reasoning for this is:

- The RSPCA website states that when considering purchasing a ‘puppy’ or ‘companion animal’ that to first look to them, or a reputable rescue organisation.
- Should it not mention a reputable domestic animal business also? We are fully inspected by the council under strict Government legislation – some of the strictest in the world. Supporting us as we support them would give customers another option and also turn them away from ‘backyard breeders.’
- Not all rescue pets are suitable for families as their start in the world has not been ideal.
- Why doesn’t the RSPCA offer de-sexing at a reduced rate, or even free, to stop the flood of unwanted dogs and cats? This would dramatically reduce the amount of dogs and cats without homes would this help or hinder them as a business.
- If they did more de-sexing and focusing on stopping the flow of animals without homes they could also focus on animal cruelty reports.

At the moment, I believe, the public do not know where to purchase their ‘puppy’ or ‘companion animal’ due to the conflict that has arisen from animal activists and hype in the media. This enquiry could go a long way to solving that if it is fully released to the public.
