SUBMISSION CONTENT:

1. Believe management of fuel load in line with first nations knowledge should be expanded
2. Permits and ability for farmers to manage pest populations of duck, cocktoos, wombats, roos, other native species and introduced species remain.
3. Duck hunting remain legal and allowed from mid march to mid june each and every year. Review guidelines on wood duck to become a pest animal due to its voracious breeding habits and ability to destroy paddocks of producing farm land.
4. Farmers should be allowed to better manage their own ecosystems and more easily be able to build fire breaks and water catchments and conduct hazard reduction burns.
5. Remove 'no dogs allowed' from national parks a well controlled dog is no risk to the environment.
6. Re open national parks for rural rec activities. More eyes on the ground lessens the danger and better notifies responsible parties of mangment concerns such as covered fire trails, washed out tracks, weeds and invasive species sightings.
7. Sustainable timber harvesting to continue for harwood.
8. Provide real rural and bush education to school age children, teach survival, bush foods, farm and fishing paddock to plate, understanding economic value of each ecosystem not the social conflict of each.
