# **Hearing in western Victoria for recycling and waste management inquiry**

On Thursday 19 September 2019, the Legislative Council’s Environment and Planning Committee continues its inquiry into recycling and waste management with a public hearing in Dunkeld.

The public hearing will be from 10 am to 2 pm in the John Myers Room, Sterling Place, Dunkeld Community Centre, 14 Sterling Street, Dunkeld.

The Committee will hear from a range of local government representatives.

Under the terms of reference for the inquiry, the Committee is examining the Victorian government's waste management approach, the response to China's waste ban and solutions to the recycling and waste crisis, including reduction strategies.

It has received more than 700 submissions and has already held public hearings in Melbourne, Morwell and Echuca.
