# **Recycling inquiry to hear from industry participants at two days of hearings**

Recycling companies, government agencies and local government representatives will present their views to the recycling and waste management inquiry during two days of public hearings next week.

The public hearings by the Legislative Council Environment and Planning Committee will be held on Monday 24 June and Tuesday 25 June in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House.

The parliamentary inquiry is examining the Victorian government's waste management approach, the response to China's waste ban and solutions to the recycling and waste crisis, including reduction strategies.

The Committee has received several hundred [submissions](#) and commenced public hearings in May.

Next week's hearings will provide the Committee with the opportunity to question a number of key participants in the recycling and waste management industry in Victoria.
