# **Recycling and packaging companies at inquiry hearing**

The parliamentary inquiry into recycling and waste management will continue its public hearings in Melbourne on Wednesday 2 October and Thursday 3 October 2019.

Recycling and packaging companies will be among those presenting to the Legislative Council's Environment and Planning Committee.

The two days of public hearings will be held at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne and will be broadcast live on the Victorian Parliament's [website](#) enabling people across the state to view the discussions.

Under the terms of reference for the inquiry, the Committee is examining the Victorian government's waste management approach, the response to China's waste ban and solutions to the recycling and waste crisis, including reduction strategies.

It has received more than 700 submissions and has held public hearings in Melbourne, Morwell, Echuca and Dunkeld.
