Echuca hearing for recycling and waste management inquiry

On Tuesday 3 September 2019, the Legislative Council's Environment and Planning Committee continues its inquiry into recycling and waste management with a public hearing in Echuca.

The public hearing will be from 12:30 pm to 4 pm at the Mercure Port of Echuca Hotel, 465 High Street, Echuca.

The Committee will hear from a range of local government representatives.

Under the terms of reference for the inquiry, the Committee is examining the Victorian government's waste management approach, the response to China's waste ban and solutions to the recycling and waste crisis, including reduction strategies.

It has received more than 700 submissions and has already held public hearings in Melbourne and Morwell.
