# **Key agencies at final hearing on recycling and waste management**

On Wednesday 6 November 2019, the parliamentary inquiry into recycling and waste management will hold its final public hearing in Melbourne with a number of key agencies.

Among those presenting to the Legislative Council's Environment and Planning Committee will be the Environment Protection Authority; the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning; Sustainability Victoria; and Infrastructure Victoria.

The public hearing will be held at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm and will be broadcast live on the Victorian Parliament's [website](#) enabling people across the state to view the discussions.

Under the terms of reference for the inquiry, the Committee is examining the Victorian government's waste management approach, the response to China's waste ban and solutions to the recycling and waste crisis, including reduction strategies.

It has received more than 700 submissions and has held public hearings in Melbourne, Morwell, Echuca and Dunkeld.
