# **Recycling companies at parliamentary hearing**

The next day of public hearings on the inquiry into recycling and waste management will be on Friday 10 May at Parliament House.

The Legislative Council's Environment and Planning Committee will hear from a range of companies involved with recycling and waste management, including Visy, Glass Recovery Services and Australian Paper.

The public hearings will be from 10:15 am to 3:00 pm in the Legislative Council Committee Room.

Also giving evidence to the Committee will be WorkSafe Victoria and Sustainability Victoria.

Last Friday the Committee held its first day of public hearings for the inquiry, when it questioned a range of organisations about chemical industrial waste storage.

The upcoming hearings will see further questioning on those issues and also begin looking at some of the broader issues associated with recycling and waste management in Victoria.
