RE: INQUIRY INTO RECYCLING AND WASTE MANAGEMENT

1. All residential and commercial food waste must be treated within local neighbourhoods to feed people or create usable compost. Close this loop locally.
2. Packaging to be minimised at source and be reusable, recyclable or compostable.
3. Recycling stations to be created within local and regional areas. Not taken overseas.
4. No recycled materials to end up in landfill- there is no 'away'. We must deal with our own waste locally.
5. Implement a container deposit scheme
6. Phase out land fill garbage bins so we deal with all our waste in a sustainable and responsible manner.
